Project title: ESBOR – Education on Systems for Building Resilience Against Radicalisation.

Project value: The total value of the project is PLN 2 920 252,00, including co-financing from the European Union's Internal Security Fund for 2021-2027 (75%) – PLN 2 190 189,00 and national budget funds (25%) – PLN 730 063,00.

Grant Agreement: Financial Agreement No. FBWP.03.01-IZ.00-0048/24 concluded on May 26, 2025.

Project implementation period: From July 01, 2025 to June 30, 2028

Project Activities:

Activity No. 1 – Consultation meetings in RP with experts regarding development of curricula for in-service training and e-learning courses on the symptoms, phenomenal and stage forms of radicalisation and a summary of the project's results and stages to date.

Activity No. 2 – Organisation of study visits abroad to collect best practices on international security cultures, counterterrorism- and resilience building activities against radicalisation leading to crime, extremism and terrorism.

Activity No. 3 – Organisation of an international conference in Warsaw involving project partners, national and international guests to present and discuss trends, recommendations, conclusions on the process and causes of radicalisation, including ways to counteract it.

Activity No. 4 - 5 - Organisation of 4 on-site training courses in the country and the development of 4 e-learning courses. The knowledge transferred during the trainings is aimed at disseminating best practices to counter radicalisation.

Activity No. 6 – Creation of a tool to quantify vulnerability to radicalisation.

Activity No. 7 – Carry out other project activities to ensure the proper and effective implementation of the project.
